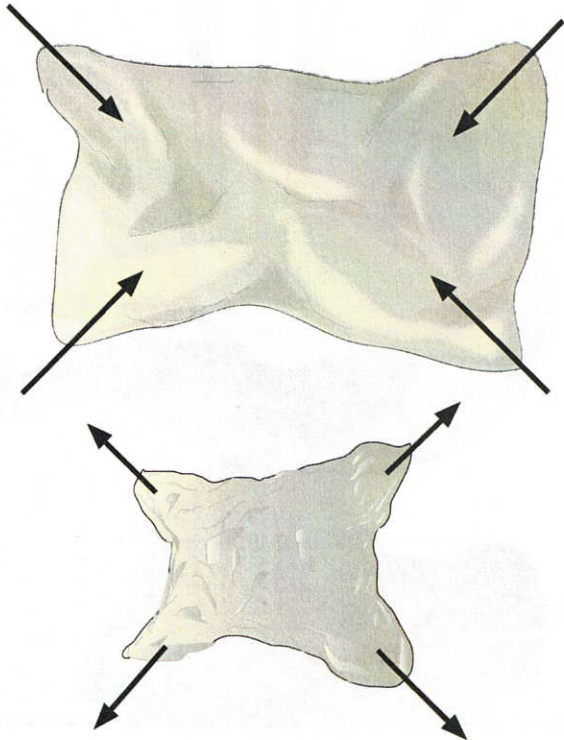
ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Wood base for understructure
- Staple gun and staples
- Clean, disposable mixing bowl
- Scissors
- Tap water
- Disposable cups (3)
- Vegetation and other materials to complete habitat

- 1** Scrunch Contour Sheet to add rock-like texture.

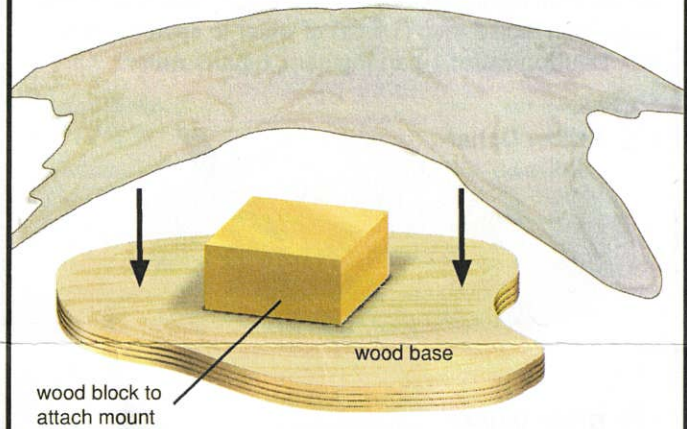
CAUTION: Sheet may have sharp edges. Cutting tools recommended. Use both with care.

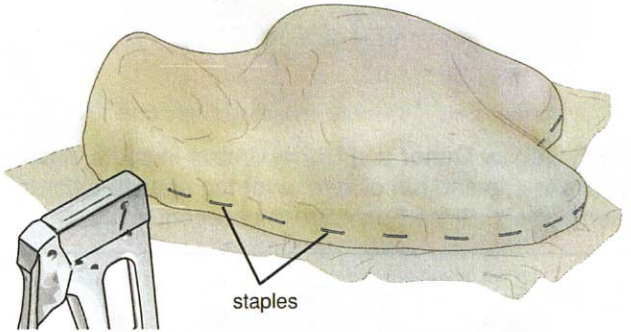

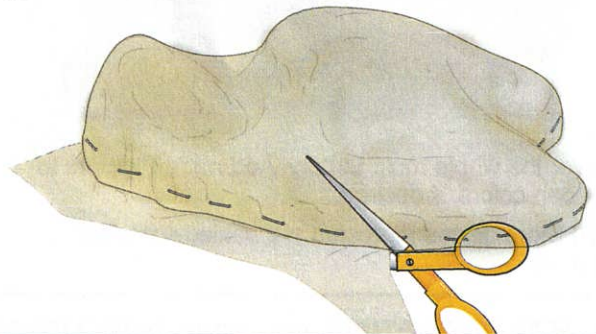
- 2** **A** Shape the Contour Sheet to wood base to form a rock formation. If mount's feet are dry, test fit and mold Contour Sheet to feet.



- B** Use staple gun and staples to secure to wood base.



- C** Cut flush with bottom edge of wood base.



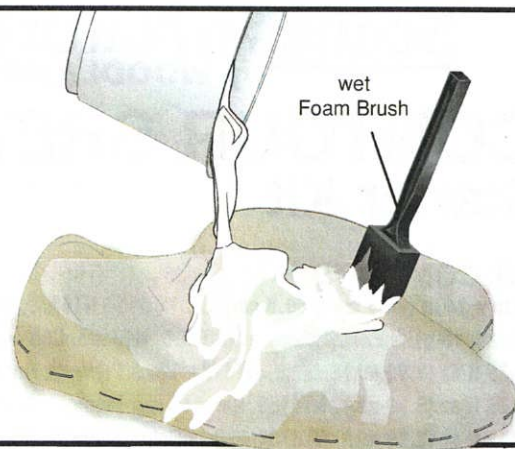
3 **Mix and apply Contour Sheet Plaster.** Use a clean, disposable mixing bowl and the included Stir Stick.

Working time: 20 minutes

Mixing ratio: 2.5-parts Contour Sheet Plaster
1-part cold water

NOTE: 7.5 fl oz Plaster and 3 fl oz water covers an area approximately 12" wide x 12" long x 1/8" deep.

- (A) Pour Plaster into cold water. Let stand 2 minutes.
- (B) Stir thoroughly 1-2 minutes.
- (C) Use immediately. **NOTE:** Do not pour excess Plaster down drain. Discard the excess Plaster, Foam Brush and mixing bowl in the trash.



4 **Color rock with Rock Color System Pigments.**

Let Contour Sheet Plaster dry 24 hours before coloring. To color, start by diluting Pigments. Empty the contents of each Pigment cup into a separate disposable cup. Then, add 2 tbsp (1 fl oz) of water to each cup and stir. **Dilution ratio:** 1-part Pigment, 6-parts water.

(A) **Yellow Ocher**



(B) **Burnt Umber**



Apply **Yellow Ocher** and **Burnt Umber** in spots. Allow colors to drip and run or layer over top of each other to blend colors. Rinse Foam Brush between colors.

(C) **Black**



Cover the whole rock. Let dry. Add more Pigment to deepen colors, if desired.

TIP! Store diluted Pigments in a sealed container for later use.

5 **Use Scenes-N-Nature habitat materials (sold separately) to complete the rock.** Then, add your own vegetation to complete the habitat, as desired.

- Lightly sprinkle on Highlights (Dark Brown, NF6208 / Brown, NF6209) to create a gritty texture. Attach with Habitat Adhesive (NF6099).
- Use Accents (NF6217-NF6220) or Highlights (Olive Green, NF6210 / Dark Green, NF6211) to create a mossy appearance.
- Add Lite Rock Debris (NT6193-NT6195) for a pebbled look.
